7. That said examination will be conducted solely for the purpose of determining the truth or falsehood of the following:

Whether Charles D. Boney was involved, in any way, in the homicides of Kimberly Camm, Jill Camm and Bradley Camm on September 28, 2000.

8. That said examiner may, at his discretion, phrase the aforementioned propositions to be tested in such a way as to conform to his manner or method of examination, so long as the substance of said propositions remains substantially unchanged; and any such alternate phrasing or propositions shall in no way affect or negate this agreement.

9. That said written report of the results of said examination may be introduced into evidence, without objection by either the State of Indiana or Charles D. Boney at the time of the examiner's testimony at any trial or hearing.

10. That Charles D. Boney hereby certifies that he understands that polygraph examination results are not allowed to be admitted as evidence under current court rules; and that Charles D. Boney **KNOWINGLY, VOLUNTARILY, AND EXPRESSLY WAIVES HIS RIGHT TO HAVE SUCH EVIDENCE EXCLUDED FROM ANY TRIAL, HEARING OR PROCEEDING.**

11. That the State and Charles D. Boney hereby expressly waive any and all objections of said examiner's testimony as to the competency, weight, relevancy, remoteness, or admissibility of such testimony based on legal, judicial, social policy, due process of law and/or such rules of evidence as might otherwise govern.
